

RESOLUTION 2024-12-05

**AWARDING CONTRACT FOR PUMP STATION MAINTENANCE FORCE
ACCOUNT (2025-2028) TO MUNICIPAL MAINTENANCE CO.**

WHEREAS, the Eatontown Sewerage Authority and its Engineer had determined that it was necessary to advertise for bids for the Pump Station Maintenance Force Account for 2025 through 2028; and

WHEREAS, the specifications required that the applicants shall provide a total base bid amount for the first year together with an amount for the two additional years, as well as an alternate bid item for three years of pump station maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer has prepared the specifications and set forth the form of contract to be entered into, which contract contains a base bid as well as two additional bid terms and an alternate bid item for the three years; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer solicited quotes for said contract in the Asbury Park Press on November 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received on December 10, 2024 for said project; (a) one from Municipal Maintenance Co., who provided a base and alternate bid of \$142,590.00 for the first year, a base and alternate bid of \$143,940.00 for the second year, and a base and alternate bid of \$145,290.00 for the third year, for a total of \$431,820.00; and (b) one from Sea Machine Mfg., LLC, who provided a base and alternate bid of \$316,315.00 for the first year, a base and alternate bid of \$ 325,714.00 for the second year, and a base and alternate bid of \$335,454.00 for the third year, for a total of \$977,483.00; and;

WHEREAS, there were no other bids received; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, the Eatontown Sewerage Authority must award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder who has conformed with the specifications and requests for the bid; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer has recommended that the Authority award the contract for the pump station maintenance force account to the lowest bidder in the total amount of \$431,820.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Eatontown Sewerage Authority, as follows:

1. That the Authority award the contract to Municipal Maintenance Co., for the pump station maintenance force account in the amount of \$431,820.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this resolution.
