Report for December 2024 Activities

Major Items:

- The new Enviro sight TV Van has been delivered . We are scheduled to have a full training session on Tuesday .
- Once we are fully trained on the TV Van we will prioritize video inspecting all incoming lines to Old orchard, circle, and maxwell pump stations. These are the pump stations that go into high water alarms with heavy rain. We will also use the lateral launch system to locate and inspect laterals with prior high blockage rates and past root issues.
- CSL Has completed the flow study and removed the flow meters on Clifford Road manhole # 95 B and Wyckoff Road manhole # 303 . the Flow studies are for Surrey Equities for the residential housing on old Orchard golf course .
- We used our new Tv push camera to view the suction line on pump 2 at country club pump station. The gate valve is completely clogged and the gate valve is damaged . I ordered a new gate valve for installation . We will have to plug the wet well and by pass from the next upstream manhole . I am currently waiting on another 50 foot discharge hose to arrive so we can reach the bypass chamber from the upstream manhole before we can complete this job.
- Our dump truck still has not been fixed , they are still waiting on parts to be delivered. The truck has been out of service for 3 months and its been an issue . I have been calling almost every week for updates and they seem to be taking their time .

- Burlington coat Factory completed the installation of a new 6 inch service line that connects to our easement in the parking lot . The approval has been written up and sent to the building department .
- The new pump has been delivered and installed at Lewis pump station .
- Version connect installed GPS tracking on the New maintenance truck in early December .The new tv van GPS is scheduled to be installed next week . They are also removing the GPS in the old TV van .
- The exhaust fan belt at industrial pump station has been replaced .
- T & M is putting together a proposal to update our maps and then update our GIS system .
- We are making progress on annual grease /oil/sand interceptor inspections . Out of the 105 we have completed 95 of them .
- Rob and I will be working together to come up with a plan to address the wear and tear at our pump stations.
- I have a meeting with our landscaping contractor to add an easement that runs from Weston to Rutland to our list . I will also be going through with the contractor every easement they cut to make sure they are not missing any .
