## Report for January 2025 Activities

## Major Items:

- The new Enviro sight TV Vans lateral launch system would not turn on during the initial training session. The tv van was dropped off to Envirosight for repair which is covered by our warranty in full.
- While plowing snow public works damaged man hole 430's frame and cover. We jack hammered out the old frame and cover and replaced it with a new one.
- Our new jet heads and root cutters should be here by next week. Once we get them we
  will root cut every lateral on our root treatment list. We will also dig up and raise all the
  clean outs that are buried.
- Once the TV Van is repaired we will prioritize video inspecting all incoming lines to Old orchard, circle, and maxwell pump stations. These are the pump stations that go into high water alarms with heavy rain. We will also use the lateral launch system to locate and inspect laterals with prior high blockage rates and past root issues.
- Update on our dump truck Jim curly GMC dealer has still not been able to locate a
  fuel pump module and repair our dump truck. I have instructed them to just fix our door
  latch and complete the air bag recall. I contacted another repair shop who ensured me
  they could find the part and replace the fuel pump. After the air bag recall and door
  latch is fixed I will be towing the dump truck to Johns Auto and truck repair in Long
  Branch.



- Verizon connect shipped over the wrong GPS device for our TV van, so the technician
  was unable to install the device last month as planned. We just received the new GPS
  this week and Verizon is scheduled to complete the installation next week.
- I met with Ruchit from T&M to discuss updating our maps with the new main lines installed after 2011. The Quote for updating the maps should be in by next week.
- We completed all of our annual grease /oil/sand interceptor inspections for 2024.
- Rob and I will be working together to come up with a plan to address the wear and tear at our pump stations.
- I am still waiting on a quote from our landscaper to add the Weston easement to our contract.

- (b) Each licensed operator shall immediately report any system deficiencies, breaks, breakdowns, problems, bypasses, pump failures, occurrences, emergencies, complaints and/or intervening factors within the system that result in or necessitate deviation from the routine O&M procedures and any situations that have the potential to affect public health, safety, welfare, or the environment or have the potential to violate any permits, regulations or laws relating to this chapter. All reports shall be made to the owner or permittee of the system to or from which treatment is provided. All violations shall be reported by the owner or permittee, as appropriate, to the Department.
- 1. Each licensed operator shall submit to the Department, upon request, a report summarizing any event described in (b) above and the remedial action taken.
- 2. Each Public Wastewater Collection System operator shall submit to the receiving system a monthly report summarizing all events described in (b) above and the remedial action taken, by the 10th day of the month following each month for which the data is collected.
